- Water saving devices are installed in all the toilet cisterns
- Our energy consumption is monitored and controlled on a monthly basis - electrical equipment is switched off when not in use, air conditioning units are set at optimum levels and we use energy saving light bulbs
- Our boilers are gradually being replaced with energy efficient versions
